

## **Graduate Internship Program**

Graduate Internships are relevant work experience available to Northern Graduates for a minimum one year period with the Government of the Northwest Territories; Interns are usually employed in positions related to their field of study.

### **Eligibility**

There are two aspects to eligibility:

- You must be a Northern graduate
- You must meet the academic eligibility

A northern graduate is an individual who has:

- Resided in the Northwest Territories for 12 months immediately prior to acceptance into post-secondary studies; AND,
- Graduated from a recognized Canadian college or university in a certificate, diploma or degree program; AND,
- Graduated within 12 months of application to the GEIP.

### **How to Apply**

1. Submit your cover letter and a current copy of your resume through the Graduate Entry-Level Internship Program (GEIP) Health and Social Services Positions job advertisement on the GNWT careers site at: [careers.hr.gov.nt.ca](http://careers.hr.gov.nt.ca)
2. If you meet the eligibility criteria, an email is sent to you indicating that you have been registered in the HSS GEIP. Registered applicants become candidates for Internships, and are retained on file for one year from the date of approval.
3. If a potential Internship match to your education and experience is found, you are contacted for an interview by a hiring manager or supervisor.
